Built to Last

The Engine Classification Lamps described herein have been designed to meet the requirements of permanency. They will defy the worst that rain and snow, heat and cold can do. Unless destroyed or injured through accident will last for many years.

These lamps are practically moisture-proof. Wiring enters from underneath bracket, and the fully-protected switch turns the light on or off from same position.

The lamp body, made of cast aluminum, is quickly removed from bracket for inspection or replacement of burned-out

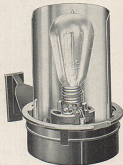
bulb. The body revolves upon bracket, permitting the exposure of either the two white or the two green lenses, depending on the signal required. A specially - designed blinder on inside of lamp shields the two lenses not in use.

Pull switch in socket is rugged in construction. Bracket is made of malleable iron.



Equipped With Flanged Base

When lamp is equipped with flanged base instead of bracket it is known as No. 1170. Wiring enters from underneath or through side of base.

In ordering please be sure to specify type of bulb to assure socket being located at proper height.
